The project

This project will be a solution for the young people that aims to build their knowledge, skills and tools in order to update themselves to the new trends understanding how to handle fake news in the day of today.

OBJECTIVES



- 1. Develop young volunteer's abilities to be better aware of fake news and spread awareness among local communities about how to handle social media
- 2. Improve the abilities of young participants in order to enhance know how, practical experience, their communication skills and self-esteem so they can persuade the people they work with.
- 3. Create 5 digital magazine guidelines and 5 video materials by all participant countries, to be promoted at local and regional level.
- 4. Promote the sense of civic responsibility, social inclusion and tolerance towards minorities, migrants and refugees, by presenting news on media channels that enforce the European values.
- 5. Enhance intercultural participation and competences of youth among local, national and European cultural heritage.


IMPACT

Participants in the project can be from any ethnicity, as long as they reside in the country their sending organization is located. They will be selected based on their motivation and interest in partaking in the project.




Health insurance for participants from non-EU countries has to be provided by the participants themselves. Participants from EU-countries are asked to use their European health insurance card.










ACCOMODATION

Travelling expenses


According to the conditions of the Erasmus + programme, participants in youth exchanges can have their travel expenses reimbursed within the amount given below. The reimbursement covers your departure from your home town (residence) to the place of activities (Laguna de Cameros). You must depart from the country you represent: for example, if you are representative of Belgium, you must depart from Belgium.







The reimbursement covers only traveling by plane, train and bus. Money paid for taxi cannot be reimbursed! Please keep all receipts and invoices with you. Print all your tickets and invoices if the tickets are bought online. IMPORTANT: You will get your reimbursement after WE HAVE RECEIVED all your travel documents. You will receive your reimbursement money through your sending organization, so you need to inform them about the details of your bank account.

- We recommend you to travel to Madrid or Barcelona if closer destinations such as Zaragoza or Bilbao are not available. From there, you can easily take buses or trains to go to Logroño where we will meet on Sunday.
- Remember that you are allowed to come earlier or after the project as long as you keep it maximum to 3 days outside of mobility dates.
- For those cases where necessary required covid tests will be organised and funded with the travel budget.
